Watch the Dalai Lama presentation Via Live Webcast on Oct. 3

On Saturday Oct. 3, 2009, from 9:15 to 11:30 a.m., the Dalai Lama will speak to 500–600 students, faculty and university dignitaries at an event hosted by McGill University. The Dalai Lama will present his views on the benefits and challenges of teaching about ethics and religious practice to today's youth.
