WITNESSING VIOLENCE

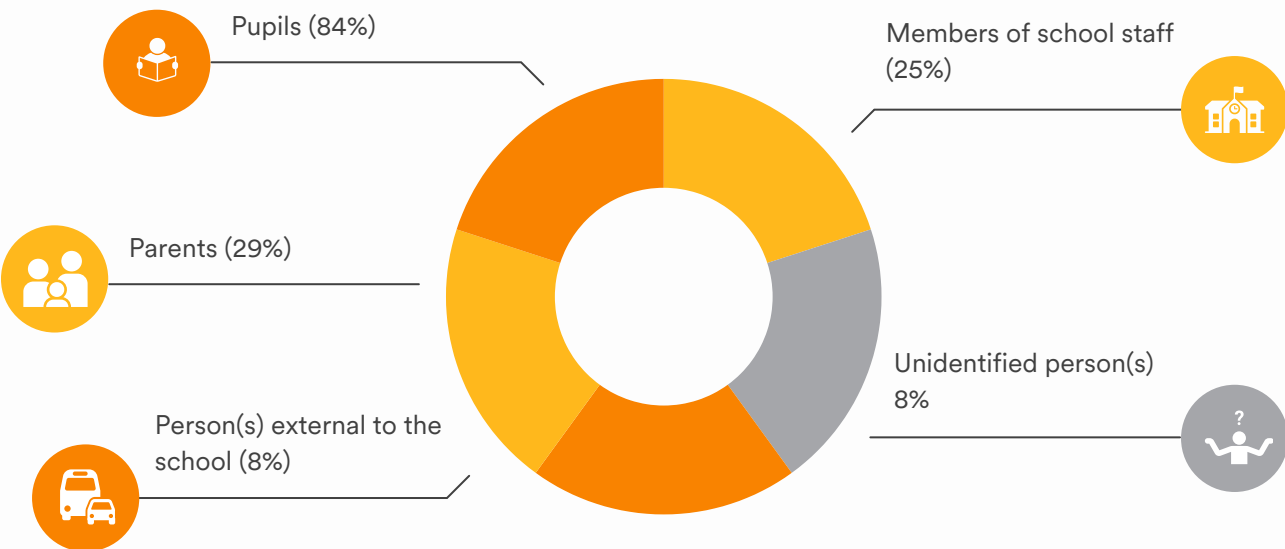
75% of respondents indicated they have witnessed violence at work in the last 12 months.

Respondents indicated they experienced violence from the following groups in the last 12 months.



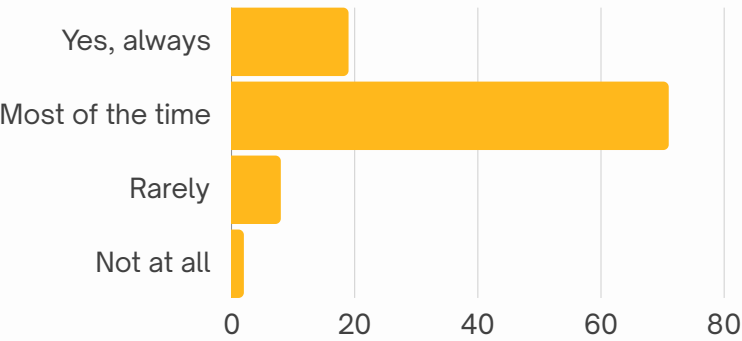
TYPES OF VIOLENCE
