



Andy Hargreaves has dedicated his life to working with teachers and schools to make learning and teaching more engaging, fulfilling and collaborative for everyone. An author or editor of almost 40 books, Hargreaves is one of the most cited education scholars alive. He has received 10 outstanding book awards, including, in 2015, the world's largest and most prestigious for his field, the \$100,000 US <u>Grawemeyer Award</u>. His works have been translated into many European languages as well as Japanese, Mandarin, Korean, Hebrew, and Arabic.

Andy is an education adviser to the First Minister of Scotland, and for the Minister of Education for New Brunswick. He holds Honorary Doctorates from Sweden, Hong Kong, and the University of Greater Manchester. He has been honoured in the UK, Canada, the US, and Australia, for services to public education and educational research, and he was awarded Boston College's Excellence in Teaching with Technology Award in 2015. In 2023, Andy was named as Canada's Post-Secondary Educator of the Year.

Andy is Past President of the International Congress of School Effectiveness and Improvement, 2018-2020; and is co-founder and President of the <u>ARC</u> Education Project: a group of governments committed to broadly defined excellence, equity, well-being, inclusion, democracy and human rights in education. Andy's most recent books are <u>The Making of an Educator: Living Through and Learning from the Great Education</u> <u>Shift</u> (2025), <u>Leadership from the Middle</u> (2024), and <u>The Age of Identity</u> (with Dennis Shirley) (2023).
